

## CROHN'S AND COLITIS CANADA RISING STAR AWARD

Crohn's and Colitis Canada is pleased to present its Rising Star Award, which recognizes an outstanding investigator in the early stages of his/her career. This award acknowledges the basic or clinical research accomplishments of a junior/newly emerging investigator in the field of Inflammatory Bowel Disease, within 5 years of their first faculty appointment. Nominated by their fellow scientists, recipients of the Rising Star Award are innovative and productive leaders who have made an outstanding contribution to supporting Crohn's and Colitis Canada's mission.

The award will be presented during a conference, symposia or appropriate research event. The recipient of the award will be expected to participate in a public lecture or research event for Crohn's and Colitis Canada.

Nominees should be a MD and/or a PhD. They should be within 5 years of their first faculty appointment and hold an appointment at a Canadian university, hospital or research institute.

The Awards Task Force will judge candidates based on the following:

- Current or future impact on IBD research, practice and policy.
- Active in promoting the mission and values of Crohn's and Colitis Canada.

## **Nomination Package**

Submissions must include:

- Completed nomination form
- Accompanying letter of support from a Senior Investigator, emphasizing the
  originality and significance of the scientific accomplishments of the candidate and
  highlighting the three or four most important contributions of the candidate to IBD
  community. Maximum 3 pages
- Updated curriculum vitae for the candidate.
