

Virtual Camp Got2Go Expectations

Virtual Camp Got2Go Camper and Parent/Guardian Expectations

Given the significant differences between this program and our typical camp programs, we will ask that parents/guardians help us in a different way than they normally would. We expect our campers to treat each other with the same amount of respect and to participate as fully in programs as they would if they were at camp.

Our expectations of our campers during Virtual Camp Got2Go participation:

1. All of our campers will interact kindly with others.
 - a. There will be no name-calling or disrespectful language.
2. Campers will listen to what others have to contribute to activities and discussions.
3. Campers will participate respectfully and will avoid being disruptive to others' experiences.

4. We'll expect that campers will participate as much as they are able to.
5. While we understand that campers may require breaks or may find it challenging to participate in virtual programs for long periods of time, we'll expect that campers arrive to the program each day and give each program the best they're capable of.

6. Campers will keep their language, topics of conversation, and their surroundings appropriate.
7. No use of drugs or alcohol before or during Virtual Village programs.
8. We expect campers to arrive to programs fully and appropriately clothed, with a background that is appropriate, as well.

Our expectations of the parents/guardians of our campers during Virtual Camp Got2Go participation:

1. While we will provide the programming content, a staff member running a program virtually is not a substitute for in-person supervision. Parents/guardians of campers are responsible for the supervision of campers during Virtual Camp Got2Go programs and to provide age-appropriate support in the activities.
2. In the event of an emergency situation (injury, seizure, mental health crisis, etc.,) parents/guardians will be responsible to provide emergency response.
3. Parents/guardians will be asked to ensure that campers are set up effectively and are prepared to participate in Virtual Camp Got2Go programming prior to the beginning of each program.
4. Wherever possible, we'll ask that parents/guardians provide a space for campers to engage in programming which is away from distractions.
5. We will ask that parents/guardians ensure that the background of campers' video remains appropriate for other campers.
6. Parents/guardians will be asked to ensure that campers are participating respectfully and appropriately in our programs and to address issues if/when they come up. Should you have any questions or concerns regarding the above expectations, please get in contact with us.
