As the Community Fundraising Connector, you will provide support to local fundraising activities, including:

- Work closely with staff partner and other volunteers to identify and build new and existing local partnerships with the goal of driving revenue opportunities
- Support relationships with local networks that immediately or in time will create, grow or sustain financial benefit to Crohn's and Colitis Canada
- Source and secure new fundraising opportunities while also helping to identify relationships that could expand to a regional or national level
- Work to secure local prize and gifting for the purpose of supporting local fundraising initiatives
- Source and establish opportunities and relationships for Third Party events or having Crohn's and Colitis Canada as the charity of choice

Time Commitment:

- 1-3 hours per week for ongoing support and liaison with staff partner, other volunteers
- Evening and weekend activity is required to attend meetings and capture high traffic times. Some daytime availability is ideal for liaison with staff partner (phone calls, emails)
- This role requires a commitment of a minimum of 1 year
